### WELCOME TO A SUPER FESTIVAL!

**WELCOME** to the fifth Out There International Festival of Circus and Street Arts. Produced by SeaChange Arts, it's the largest free event of its kind in the Eastern region.

Out There 2012 is truly a landmark edition - the biggest programme to date with 28 artistic companies, 140 performers, 40 acts and over 100 performances including 8 UK premieres. We've extended to 6 days, with an exciting midweek programme leading up to the big weekend. The line-up is more

international than ever with some of the world's best artists coming from France, Belgium, Holland, Denmark, Ireland, America, Spain, Colombia, Portugal and of course the UK.

We go indoors for the first time, as the Hippodrome (the UK's only remaining purpose built circus) plays host to the stunning aerial acrobatics from Compagnie Bam on Friday night - don't miss it.

The action-packed indoor and outdoor programme combine, in one of the biggest and most exciting contemporary circus festivals in the UK, as Great Yarmouth continues to build its reputation as the UK Capital of Circus Arts.

A landmark show you can't miss this year is the towering Saturday night spectacular 'Waterlitz' by world-renowned pioneers of street arts Générik Vapeur. This 20m tall figure made from shipping containers will come alive with projections, pyrotechnics, a live rock band and breath taking aerial performance. Waterlitz has been specially commissioned by SeaChange in partnership with our

ZEPA network of 9 French and English festivals - all committed to enriching lives and places through street arts. It is also an official event of the London 2012 Festival. We're delighted to welcome back this visionary company that you will remember for their incredible show 'Bivouac' at Out There 2010.

It's also a landmark year for SeaChange Arts. We have moved into our first permanent working base - the historic 12,000 square foot Drill House at the heart of Great Yarmouth. The Drill House provides space for a year round programme of creative workshops for the local community in circus, parkour and theatre. Local, national and international artists use the space throughout the year to rehearse, create and perform new work, often showcased at the Out There Festival and other events. Future plans will be centred around offering world class facilities for local people interested in the arts and also to the street arts and circus sector - the only such facility in the UK.

The festival's European partnerships are stronger than ever. The birth and dramatic growth of Out There over the past five years has had much to do with the support of the ZEPA network. This is the final year of ZEPA in its current form and, as well as Waterlitz, the programme is rich in the quality and diversity of 'ZEPA Artists'. In addition to ZEPA, SeaChange Arts is working through four additional European street arts and circus projects, exchanging great art and creating year round opportunities for artists and communities and leading the UK field in this work.

Over five years Out There has built a national reputation for world class artistic quality, new and diverse work, regional artistic talent, international collaboration and innovative community engagement. This year's programme is more spectacular, dramatic and hilarious than ever. There's something for everyone and so much to enjoy we urge you to come for more than one day to really make the most of it. It's a special year - be part of it!

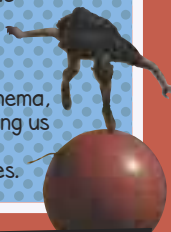

ZEPA has brought together five UK and four French street theatre and outdoor arts producers and festivals.

The partnership is now in its final year and SeaChange has worked alongside the partners producing, commissioning and supporting many shows and projects, and sharing both knowledge and artists.

Partners have presented work across the streets of the INTERREG region and at events and festivals - from Cornwall to Brittany, Great Yarmouth to Amiens, Newhaven to Sotteville-Lès-Rouen... and many places in between!

With artistic and social exchanges including workshops, volunteering opportunities, education and inter-generational projects, the ZEPA network has, to date, involved over 75 artistic companies and audiences in the hundred-thousands.

We welcome back this year ZEPA Associate Company Générisk Vapeur who wowed us in 2010... and will do the same this year with their fantatsic new show, Waterlitz.

MANY of the contemporary circus acts performing in this year's festival are supported through the PASS Circus Channel international partnership.

SeaChange Arts are part of this new cross-channel collaboration which aims to develop circus arts on a local, national and international level.

Funded by the Interreg IV A England (Channel) France programme; SeaChange Arts is working with seven other organisations from the UK and France. The partners will provide more people with the opportunity to see high quality contemporary circus performances, as well as supporting production, touring and training for both artists and professionals in the industry.

PASS Circus Channel will directly benefit residents of Great Yarmouth and Norfolk, bringing an annual large-scale circus show to the Hippodrome as part of the Norfolk and Norwich Festival. It will increase the quality and quantity of indoor and outdoor contemporary circus performances at the Out There Festival, and offer development and training opportunities for artists who will be able to promote their work across the partnership and to other festivals and promoters.

## OUT THERE... IN THE COMMUNITY

HOW SEACHANGE WORKS THROUGHOUT THE YEAR TO BRING THE OUT THERE FESTIVAL TO THE PEOPLE OF GREAT YARMOUTH.

SeaChange Arts runs a year round programme of creative activities for the local community. We deliver regular activities for children and young people every week at the Drill House and during the holidays and we manage high quality, popular events, festivals and community programmes, the majority of them free.

We work closely with local groups, schools and organisations with the aim of building community pride, participation and cohesion and offering individuals (in particular children, young people, unemployed and older people) meaningful opportunities for self-development, learning and enjoyment through the arts.

We specialise in circus and street arts and related art forms such as dance, parkour, theatre, music and the visual arts. We work with local artists as well as great companies from Europe and our events and programme aim to be inspiring, original and very accessible. We also work with local and regional partners to help them meet growing public demand for street arts and circus by incorporating it into their existing promotions.

The Out There International Festival of Circus and Street Arts is held every September in Great Yarmouth. However, Out There provides creative opportunities for local people and artists throughout the year. This year, two creative projects led up to the festival working with two international artistic companies from very different countries.

In April this year, artists from Irish company Bui Bolg worked with five local artists, from fields as diverse as puppetry, carnival arts and textiles, to design and develop a larger than life washing line decorated with swimsuits from the Victorian era to the 1950s. The final piece will be hung in St George's Park at this year's festival.

The project also involved eight young people, aged 13 to 17 drawn from Norfolk Schools. Working on an alternative education course, the Creative Gateway, they attended a workshop with the artists, learning how to cut out patterns and decorate the swimsuits with muslin. Have a look and see if you can spot the giant costumes, trunks and the flamingo!

Latin American carnival arts company ArtLat spent two weeks in Great Yarmouth creating a stunning large-scale carnival float which will be used in a performance on the Friday of the festival.

The show is based on the legends and myths of the Amazon and local artists helped make Anacondas, toucans and condors to decorate the float. The company also worked with a dozen local dancers who learnt traditional dance steps in preparation for the performance alongside professional carnival artists.



### PARKOUR TRAINING

Since March 2012 SeaChange Arts have been delivering parkour training for a group of young people aged 12-25 at the Drill House.

Professional tutors from the Parkour Alliance have been running fortnightly sessions, regularly attended by around 20 young people. There, they have been learning how to vault, flip and dash their way through our homemade urban environment. These young people will now be putting their training into practice and performing some amazing displays with the Parkour Alliance team as part of the festival.

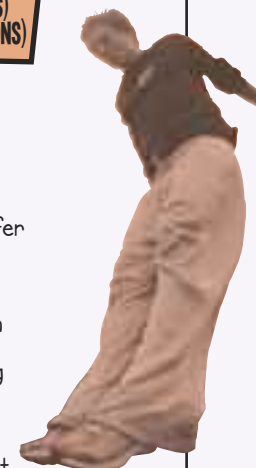

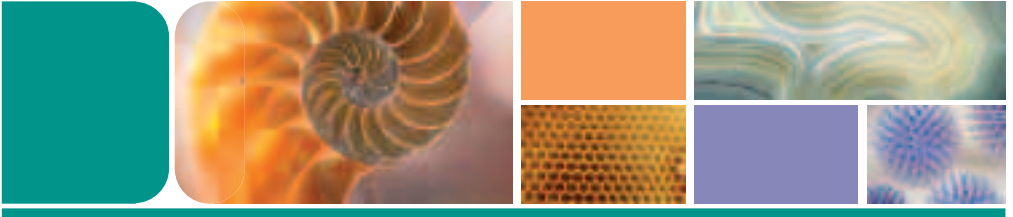
